We continue to be kept informed by the BAO (Bereavement Authority of Ontario) on a regular basis of any changes to the Provincial Guidelines which are mandatory for us to follow. Our Superintendent, Darlene, continues to do an amazing job keeping current and implementing these changes.

Our Annual General Meeting, which is normally held in May, has not taken place as of this writing. When a date is set all details will be shared on our website and Facebook page. Although we were unable to have our Family or Decoration Day, we are happy to say we are beginning to plan for our annual Remembrance Day Service to be held on November 10th at 4:30PM. Columbarium Project: Back in our May newsletter we were happy to share with you our plan on creating a 35ft (10.7m) circle around the tower Columbarium we have on a knoll just east of the office and that it was our hope to start surrounding it with 5 lower Columbaria. After some planning we have gone ahead with a 40ft (12.2m) circle and 7 lower Columbaria The larger circle allows us to have more space

between the Columbaria on all sides to allow for a more accessible access. We are also pleased to share that the initial work has been completed by Adam Kooistra (AK Custom Landscapes) and the circle and footings for the Columbaria are in place with one of the Columbaria ordered. This will be a project with phases over the next 2 to 3 years but we remain committed to keeping it as presentable as possible.

Unused, or empty, shepherd hooks have been removed but not thrown out. We ask that you please take these with you and store them at home when you are not going to use them. We like to keep your Cemetery as neat as we possibly can, so please try to follow up on this small detail and if you can't, let us know and we will remove items for you however we will not store them. Our Cemetery bylaws, which are on our website, give detailed information about this, and we are always happy to answer any questions.
