## **BOARD NEWS**

Although a little later in the month than usual, here we are, another six months has passed since our last newsletter, and it is time for another update. While some things have changed, others have remained the same, and while the numbers of those with the current strain of COVID-19 continue to fluctuate we hope this newsletter continues to find you and your family in good health.

We've been hard at work improving the Cemetery since the spring. We have a new Niche wall added by the Columbarium near the office, with the installation of paving stones set to start soon. We have also paved the upper part of the Cemetery near our nature trail and the crematorium and created a packed gravel drive leading to the office.

Our Property Chair, Ron Hansey, has been hard at work. He has added a new watering station, planted new trees to replace the ones lost by the various windstorms, and along with volunteers spread approximately 175 cubic yards of mulch on the nature trails.

Our AGM saw a couple of individuals come out to hear and learn everything that has been happening at the Cemetery over the last couple of years. It also saw Janna Munkittrick-Colton volunteer to join the board. We thank her for volunteering and welcome her and her experience.

**Remembrance Service:** Our annual service for Remembrance will take place on Thursday, November 10<sup>th</sup>. This year we will be STARTING EARLIER at 4:15PM. We look forward to seeing everyone for this important annual event, and like previous years we will be recording it and putting it online so that those who aren't able to join us in person may still do so virtually.

Unused, or empty, shepherd hooks have been removed but not thrown out. We ask that you please take these with you and store them at home when you are not going to use them. We like to keep your Cemetery as neat as we possibly can, so please try to follow up on this small detail and if you can't, let us know and we will remove items for you; however, we will not store them. Our Cemetery By-laws, which are on our website, give detailed information about this, and we are always happy to answer any questions.
